




Sunte

- Exchange student at Princeton University in New Jersey
- He disappeared without a trace (OR DID HE?!?!?) in 1915
- His disappearance (Murder????) remains UNSOLVED as of 2008

Before The Incident

 - No, that's East Pyne. ² He lewks kinda confuzed...




- 1. According to a letter written to his advisor dated September 4th, 1910: "Je suis récemment devenu orphelin à cause de la grippe. Je n'ai donc pas finir mes devoirs. Mes excuses."
- 2. One of the centrally located buildings on the campus of Princeton University. In 1915, it housed the collection of the University library, until it was moved to Firestone Library in 1948.
